Key Information:	 The GCSE Geography course is a two year, linear curriculum. Linear means that students will sit all their exams at the end of the course. The qualification is 100% examination based. Marks for spelling, punctuation and grammar (SPAG) are awarded on all three papers. Paper 1 assesses physical geography topics Paper 2 assesses human geography topics. Section A of paper 3 is designed to be synoptic in that students will be required to draw together knowledge, understanding and skills from the full course of study. Pupils also undertake two geographical enquiries, each of which include the use of primary data, collected as part of a fieldwork exercise which informs section B of paper 3.
