Ensemble performances must be at least 1 minute in duration and my compromise of one or more pieces.</li> <li>Paper 2: Pupils must submit two compositions, one in response to a Pearson set brief of at least 1 minute in duration, and one free composition of at least 1 minute in duration.</li> <li>Paper 3: - 1:45hr Set work listening and appraising exam.</li> </ul>
Key Information:	<ul> <li>The GCSE Music course is a two year, linear curriculum.</li> <li>The qualification is 40% examination based 60% NEA (Non Exam Assessed).</li> <li>Paper 3 will ask for pupils to have knowledge of 8 set works studied throughout the course as well as some unfamiliar music from similar musical genres, styles, periods and composers.</li> </ul>
